STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

The student and in the case of a student under legal age his or her parent or Guardian has the right to cancel enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid until midnight of the fifth business day following the student's first actual day of the classroom attendance. A business day means a day in which the student is scheduled to attend class session. The Academy shall end any money paid by the student within 45 days after it received the notification of cancellation. Notice of cancellation maybe given by mail, hand delivery, or fax. The notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form, is effective if it states that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the agreement.
